This matter came for a hearing before this Honorable Court on November 9, 2015 on the Exception of Prematurity, or in the Alternative Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Arbitration filed by Defendant, The Velez Corporation D/B/A CRDN of Louisiana.

After considering the pleadings, memoranda, and oral argument of counsel:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that The Velez Corporation D/B/A CRDN of Louisiana's Exception of Prematurity is GRANTED, dismissing the claims of Christopher Butler against The Velez Corporation D/B/A CRDN of Louisiana in their entirety without prejudice; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that The Velez Corporation D/B/A CRDN of Louisiana's Motion to Stay Proceedings Pending Arbitration is GRANTED, ordering a stay of this litigation to remaining parties for (1) sixty (60) days following November 9, 2015; or (2) the rendition of a decision in any arbitration proceeding between Christopher Butler and The Velez Corporation D/B/A CRDN of Louisiana, whichever shall occur first. This stay order will expire on its own terms as set forth in the preceding sentence.
