ORDER

A three (3) day jury trial is scheduled for January 29, 2018 (Rec. Doc. 104). The sole issue for the jury to determine is Haynes' claim for statutory penalties/attorney's fees and general damages.

On December 15, 2017 Americas Insurance filed the following four motions in limine, which comprise 3454 pages of material:

Motion to Exclude Evidence of Certain Damages (Rec. Doc. 139) **(1240 pages)**;

Motion to Exclude Evidence of Attorney Disputes or Bias (Rec. Doc. 140) **(784 pages)**;

Motion to Exclude Witnesses (Rec. Doc. 141) **(670 pages)**;


Motion to Exclude James Schratz or to Limit His Testimony (Rec. Doc. 142) **(760 pages)**;

As to the **Motion to Exclude Witnesses (Rec. Doc. 141)**, this motion is **DENIED AS MOOT** because the Court will not allow any witness to testify at trial if that witness has not submitted to a deposition. Therefore, if Anthony Odeh and Mariah Odeh have not submitted to a deposition they will not testify at trial under any circumstances.

As to the remaining motions, Americas shall deliver a hard copy of each of these motions to the Court's chambers. In light of the holidays, Americas shall contact chambers on December 27, 2017, to make arrangements for the delivery. The copies delivered must be printed from the Court's CM/ECF filing system so that each page contains the CM/ECF document header. Each

motion in its entirety must be placed in a separate three-ring binder with all exhibits labeled and tabbed for the Court's ease of use.
